Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act (2002).

I now respond to your request as follows:

*"I would be grateful if you could provide information regarding the number of teaching rooms at Glasgow Kelvin College that have CO2 monitors installed."*

- The College had 140 CO2 monitors delivered by the Scottish Government
- 3 monitors are now damaged and unusable
- The remaining 137 are distributed around four campuses as follows:
