Report by Assistant Principal, Estates, Corporate Planning and Governance

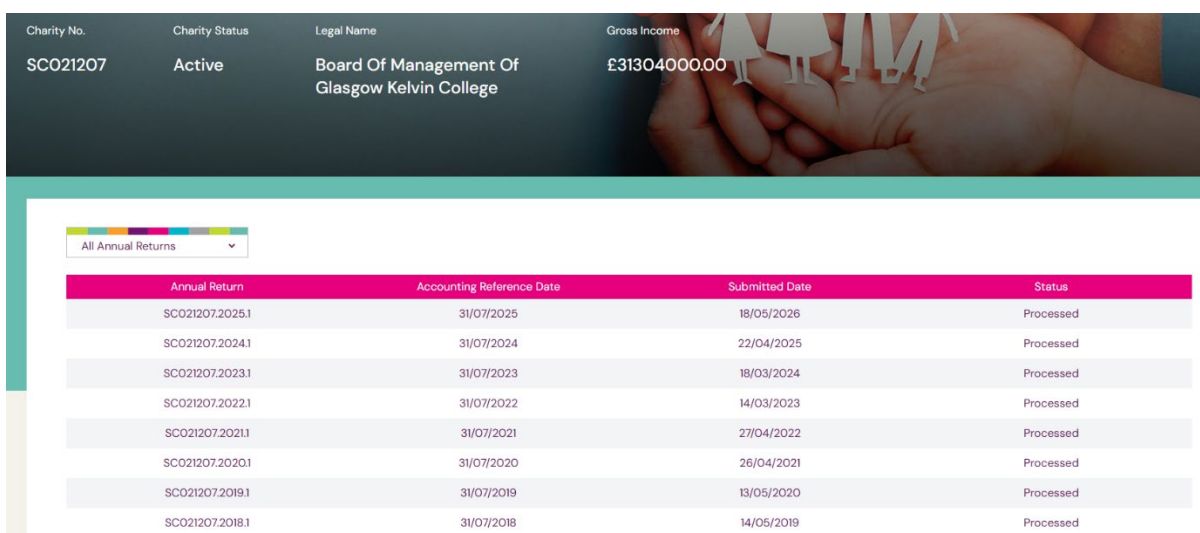
1. Introduction
